# Background: Family Tree - Raja Pachpal Bahadur

1. Family Tree (Shijra) of Raja Pachpal Bahadur was maintained over the generations in Persian Language, the official language of Mughal Empire, this is indicative in presence of a large number of Persian (Farsi) terms in the Shijra. It was translated to Urdu language and updated on 10 August 1897, most likely by Shri Mool Chand Ji who had settled in Jaipur, as is suggestive by timeline.
2. In the year 1980 Honourable Justice Shri Shambhu Dayal Singh, who had a copy of the Shijra helped his nephew, Prof. Ravindra Singh Bhatnagar, in translating the line of descent from Raja Pachpal Bahadur down to Rai Budh Singh and thereafter of our own family.
3. Later an old copy of the Shijra (in Urdu) was handed over to Prof. Ravindra Singh Bhatnagar by his cousin, Shri Mahesh Dayal Singh. Prof. Bhatnagar did his bit in the "Family Tree" by incorporating some additional information and corrections that he gathered from the book written by his grandfather, Rai Sahib Kishan Dayal Singh "Moksha Marg Pradeepika" (मोक्ष मार्ग प्रदीपिका) published on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1938.
4. He took over 20 years to compile all the information. This information was put on website in year 2000, with help of Prof. Bhatnagar's nephew, Col Sudhanshu Singh. Twenty years later Col Sudhanshu Singh came forward with some useful suggestions and got the entire family tree information, including some events, translated from Urdu to Hindi and English. He also did research and helped in logically extrapolating the historical dates.
5. Prof. Bhatnagar has been working in updating and correcting the information about the extensive family since last 40 years. The timeline of the respective generations are suggestive, as no accurate data is on record. The entire tree containing the descent from Raja Pachpal Bahadur to the recent has been translated in Hindi and English, and is published here.
6. For matter of convenience and interest, only the lines of descent from Rai Sevak Ram (1725 AD) have been taken for detailing up to the latest available information. Despite best efforts, some information is still lacking, which needs to be updated, when available. Each individual is given a unique number. It includes names of women and spouses, which were not there in the original tree. Nick names, if any, and the names of spouses are given within brackets.
7. Hopefully the mammoth exercise will certainly help understanding the inter relationships of the extended families and also inculcate a sense of belonging amongst all.



# Events of 1580s : Raja Pachpal Bahadur

Family of Raja Pachpal Bahadur lived on the banks of **Yamuna River** in **Kasba Kusana** (present day Uttar Pradesh). Sometime approximately in the year 1582, there was a feud with Rawa-Rajputs ('Rawa Rajput' itself is a complete caste with many gotra and number of villages. Almost all Rawa Rajputs have their roots in some or other village of western UP) which resulted in entire family being killed including all men, women and children. Only survivor was mother of Raja Pachpal Bahadur who was pregnant and happened to be at her maternal home at the time. Raja Pachpal Bahadur was born approximately in the year 1583. When he grew up, he reclaimed his position in Akbar's court as a Raja and avenged the killing of his family. A stone describing this battle was installed by him in a corner on the wall of the entrance to the Fort. **(Above information is given at the bottom centre of Urdu Shijra)**





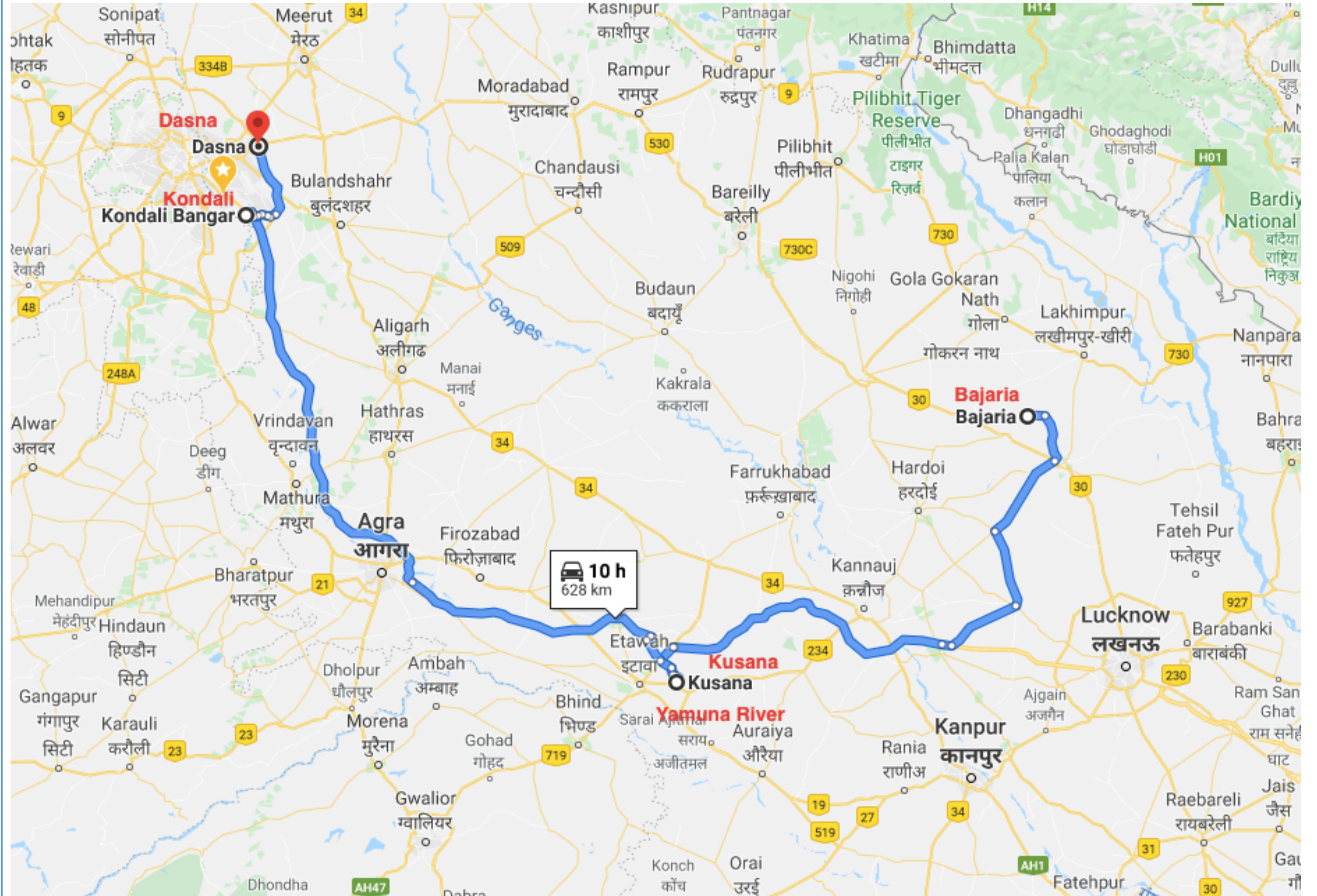
# Dasania Raizadey

Raja Pachpal Bahadur, who was titled RAIYAN (King of Kings), had two children Shivraj Bahadur and Jaidev Singh.

Shivraj Bahadur was the elder son and heir to the title of RAI (Raja). He was appointed **Subedar of Dasna**. Thus he was called Rai Shivraj Bahadur and his descendants were called **Dasania Raizadey** (Children of Rai). His descendants were also called **Bajarias**. He used to travel to Delhi very often and his entourage had horsemen and foot soldiers wielding swords. In addition there were fifty two palkis. He had constructed four temples and dharmshalas.

Jaidev Singh was nominated a prince without any legal authority or inheritance. He was permitted to attend the Royal Court. Thus was called Kunwar Jaidev Singh. Details of descendants of Kunwar Jaidev Singh are not known. His descendants were called **Dasania Pheruye** (Children of Pheru- Farsi word meaning Pursuer). His descendants were also called **Kondalia/ Kondaliwal**.

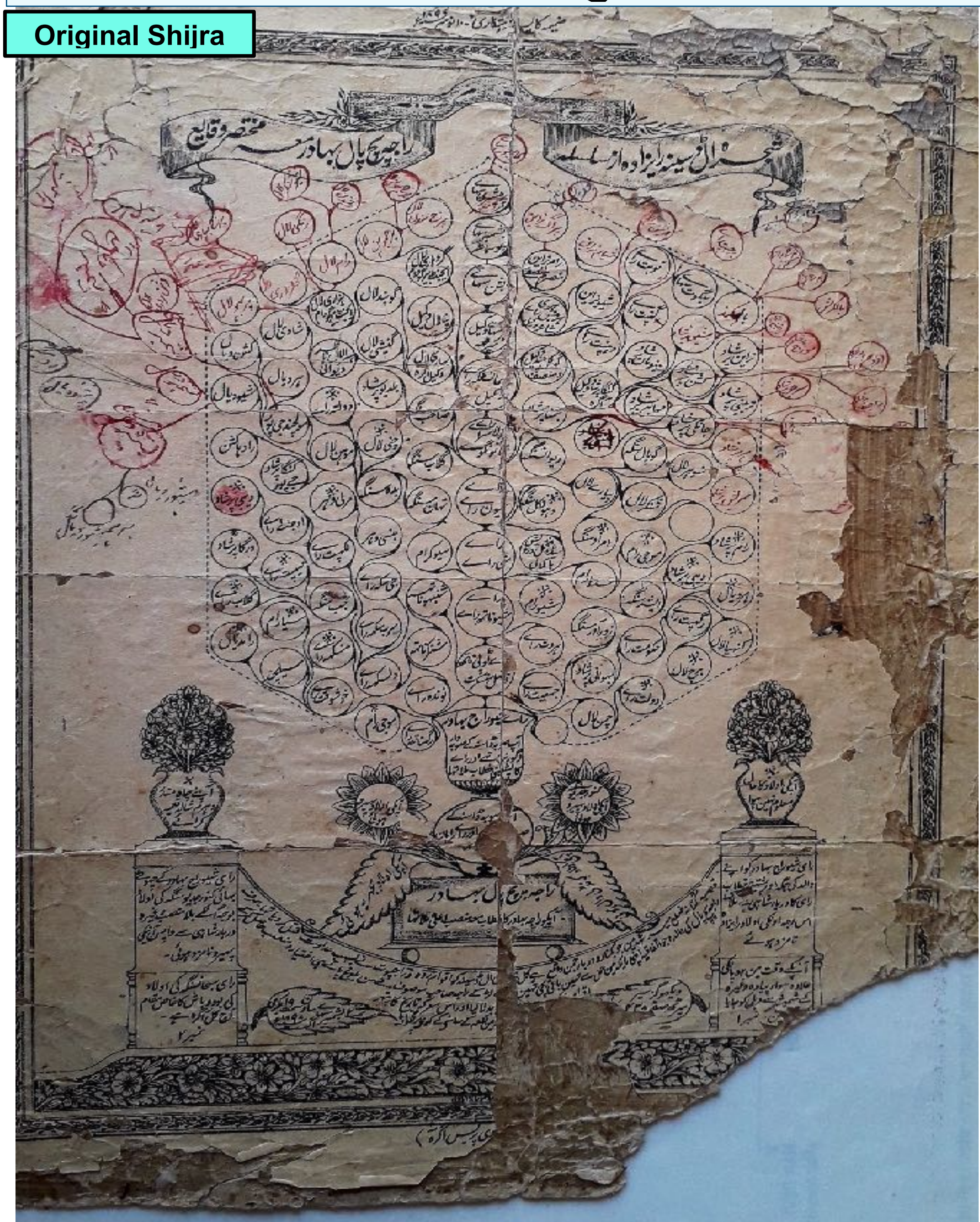




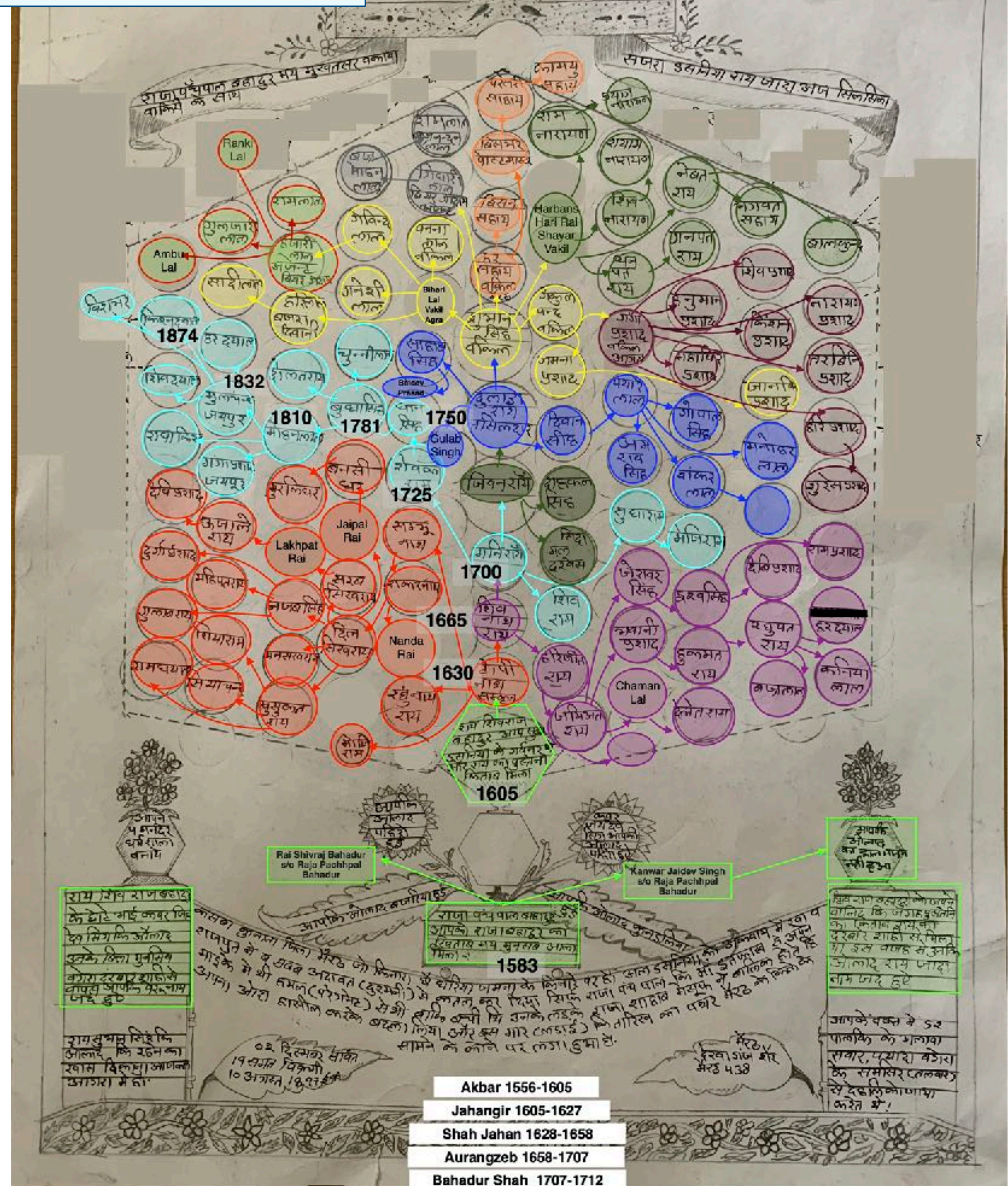

**Raja Pachhpal Bahadur- 1583 AD**  
(Was entitled "RAIYAN" (King) with Highest Legal Authority, appointed Subedar of DASNA by Akbar. The Governor, well known by the name Subedar was appointed directly by the Emperor and was the main officer looking after civil and administrative responsibility of his Suba.)

**Rai Shivraj Bahadur- 1605 AD**  
(Was given the Family Title RAI (King) by the Royal Court, and the descendants were called RAIZADEY, He was appointed Governor of Suba Dasna, with AL DASANIYA (The superiors of Dasna), so the descendants were called DASANIYA RAIZADEY.  
During Mughal rule, while conferring a title on a Chief the word Raja or Rai was added to the name of person.)

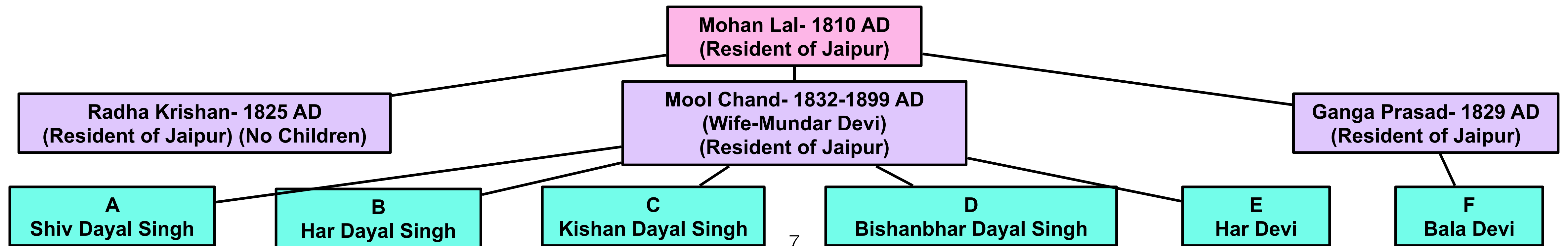

## Munshi Mool Chand- 1832-1899 AD. (Wife-Mundar Devi)

- Munshi Mool Chand** retired as Post Master, Aligarh in 1887. He was appointed Superintendent, State Postal Department in Sirmore Riyasat, Nahan. Later he resigned there too and shifted to Jaipur, where his two elder brothers were already staying. His family had shifted to Jaipur earlier. He got a pension of Rs. 18/- per month, and had to go to Sambhar to draw the pension, as the Government Treasury was located there. A house was rented in Johari Bazaar at Rs. 3/- per month. Another Rs. 3/- per month was paid to the man who supplied water.
- Shau Dayal Singh of Aligarh, appointed by Shri Mool Chand ji in Postal Department, worked at Post Office, Sambhar. He wanted to help Shri Mool Chand Ji so he met Shri Sawan Das, Superintendent Post Offices and was instrumental in getting jobs for Mool Chand ji's three elder sons **Shiv, Har and Kishan**.
- Shrimati Mundar Devi** (w/o Shri Mool Chand) had three brothers (names not known). Their children were:
  - One brother's children:
    - Manohar Lal → his son Dr. Murli Dhar of Banaras.
    - Ram Prasad → his son Hazari Lal, Retd. Post Master, Kota.
  - Another brother's children:
    - Beni Prasad → no children.
    - One daughter (name not known) → her son Kashi Ram.
  - Third brother's children:
    - Har Narain Swaroop of Panchgali, Jaipur.
    - Laxman Swaroop → no children. (He was Phupha of Shri Hari Narain Bhatnagar, retd. Station Master, of Gopal Bari, Jaipur.)

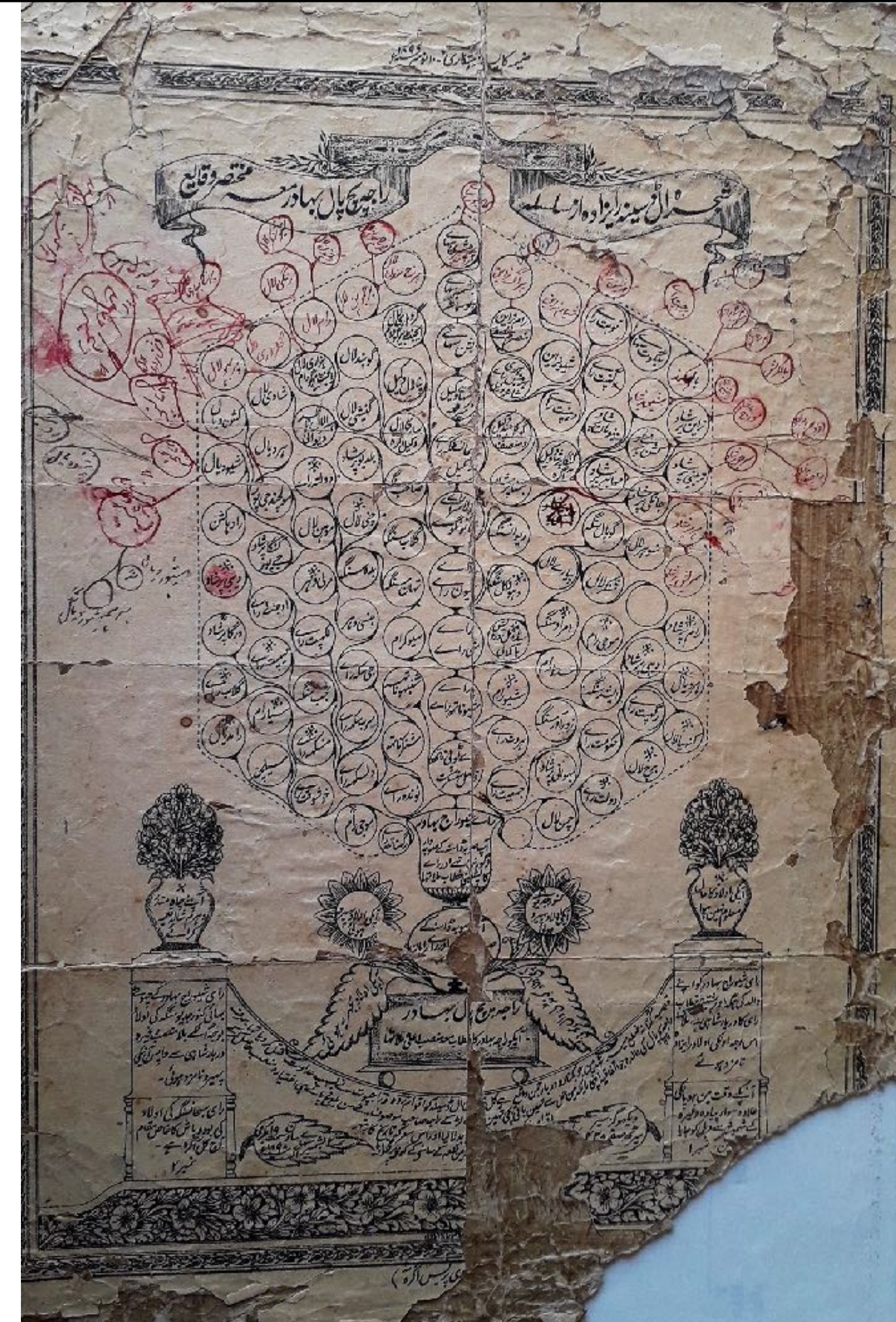

Family Tree (Shijra) of Raja Pachpal Bahadur was maintained over the generations in Persian Language, the official language of Mughal Empire, this is indicative in presence of a large number of Persian (Farsi) terms in the Shijra. It was translated to Urdu language and updated on 10 August 1897, most likely by Shri Mool Chand Ji who had settled in Jaipur, as is suggestive by timeline.
